## Welcome, Volunteers and Thank You!

Please Register online at: [www.daytonhabitat.volunteerhub.com](http://www.daytonhabitat.volunteerhub.com) and sign a liability waiver form. This is a mandatory legal requirement for Habitat for Humanity.

- At this time masks will still be required on-site, and the number of volunteers may be limited.
- Schedules for construction projects are very fluid and depend on many factors, such as weather.

**WEAR:** Boots or shoes with sturdy soles (no sandals), a hat, and sunscreen.

**BRING:** Basic hand tools, hammer, nail apron, tape measure, pencil, work gloves.

**MINIMUM AGE:** 18 years (14 -17-year-old volunteers must be accompanied by a parent or guardian) and can not work on the site when power equipment (saws, etc.) are being used. This is an insurance mandate for Dayton Ohio Habitat for Humanity.

**HOURS:** Tuesday - Friday 8:30 am until 4:00 pm, Thursday evenings 4:00 pm - dark  
& Saturday 8:30 am to 4:00 pm
