My Ministry of Administration and Management



I began working as the Business Manager at St. Charles Borromeo Parish in January 2014. I remember my new boss, Father Dan Meyer, welcoming me to "parish ministry" on my first day. I could feel the color draining from my face when he said that I was in "parish ministry." I told him that I wasn't a "minister" and that I was just a "regular Catholic." I said that I was not prepared or trained to be a minister. He advised me otherwise and we agreed to disagree. I wondered if I made a mistake in taking the job.


Since that time, I have settled into my role as a parish minister of administration & management. However, my ministry has grown far beyond managing the assets. Over the years I have been a part of the joys, comforts, and sorrows that you could only find by working in a church. I witnessed the joy of families quietly sharing their abundance to support the needs of the parish. I will never forget the feeling that came over me while meeting with an elderly woman who was deeply concerned that she could not make her \$2 weekly offertory donation because of unexpected bills. Her gift was truly sacrificial, and she was so committed to her faith and her parish. It has also been my privilege to represent the parish community by helping those who needed assistance with mortgage, rent, or utility through our Diakonia fund. I have grown as a Catholic and I am honored to be a steward of our parish resources.

Reflecting on that first day of employment and comparing what I thought a Business Manager would do to the day-to-day responsibilities of the job, I realized that my faith was stronger, and I was better equipped to be a minister than I knew. I realized that I was where God needed me to be.

1 Peter 4:11, "Whoever preaches, let it be with the words of God; whoever serves, let it be with the strength that God supplies, so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong glory and dominion forever and ever."

It is part of our mission and our duty to be in service and to minister to others. In your vocation and in whatever stage of life you are in, have the faith and confidence that you are prepared to be ministerial when needed, and go forth to love and serve one another.


