SHARING GOD'S LOVE WITH THOSE WE SERVE

As the first phases of the national vaccine effort begin to reach the arms of our most vulnerable neighbors, we continue to find many within our community that have been greatly affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. Thanks to the generous contributions from many of you to our conference, we have been able to respond to the many calls we receive from neighbors requesting assistance with food, emergency shelter, and various financial issues in areas such as rent, utilities, and furniture. Throughout the year we have partnered with The Miami Valley Community Action Partnership (MVCAP) to bring Montgomery County grant funds to bear on these bills when possible. Assistance often takes the form of a shared payment where we provide part of the funds needed to begin the process and then work closely with MVCAP to bring in external funds for the remaining costs. This cost sharing has enabled us to handle the significant bills that are surfacing at this time.

During a recent contact we met a family where the primary wage earner had been laid off due to a reduction in staff at his employer. The neighbor had a strong desire to find supplemental employment but needed help paying rent until he found employment or was able to get unemployment assistance. In the three months it took him to find employment, our conference paid the first month's rent while we helped him apply and ultimately receive the next two month's rent from MVCAP funds. Our ability to bridge the financial needs of neighbors is critical to keeping families and those greatly affected safe in this unprecedented time of need.
