During this reporting period, the COVID-19 virus impacts to our neighbor's lives has necessitated the delivery of financial support via unemployment benefits and lump sum payments from the government. This combined with moratoriums on eviction and utility shut-offs has greatly assisted the many neighbors that are now unemployed and without income. Unfortunately, we anticipate the large rent and utility bills that have accumulated will be due in the coming months. We continue to provide food, financial and other support through this crisis period.

The central and most basic activity of the conference has always been the call taking and visitation of the needy in their homes. An example situation where we have made a difference can be insightful. During a recent contact, we met a 71-year-old neighbor who had been laid off and was not able to pay her rent. She was not eligible for the special unemployment program due to her low earned income prior to the COVID-19 event. The neighbor was receiving small Social Security payments but needed a part-time job to make ends meet. She had applied for several new jobs and was waiting to hear from the potential employers. We were able to pass along several additional job opportunities. Our conference assisted with payment for her rent which afforded her the time she needed to find employment.
