



EdChoice scholarship changes for Ohio!

Free or reduced tuition at St. Albert the Great School

Last week, Governor DeWine signed into law a budget which makes the Ohio EdChoice program available to ALL Ohio Students! This new plan allows for Universal EdChoice Scholarships to be used at participating private schools, immediately for the upcoming 2023-2024 school year.

What does the EdChoice scholarship mean for Ohio students and families?

Scholarships are income based and the new qualifying criteria for a full scholarship increased from 250% of Federal Poverty Level (FPL) to 450%. As an example, this means that a family of 4 with an adjusted gross income of \$135,000 qualifies for the full scholarship! Families above 450% FPL will qualify to receive a reduced scholarship amount at a minimum level of 10%. This change impacts many of our current families who have not been eligible for EdChoice in the past. The chart below highlights income amounts for various family sizes to see if you may now qualify. Additionally, the full EdChoice Scholarship amount has been increased from \$5,500 to \$6,165 for K-8 students.

Please refer to the table provided to determine your voucher amount. **Every Ohio student is now eligible for some amount of scholarship—if not free!**
