



Dick Strominger Deacon **Kettering Catholic Community**

My call to the Diaconate

Did you ever wake up and wonder how you managed to end up where you are today? Well, without a doubt, in my case, the Lord gets the credit!



In 1984, I was introduced to Fr. Angelo Caserta, the pastor of St. Boniface Parish in Piqua. He encouraged me to get involved in his Sunday evening Bible study and prayer group. He soon had me teaching second grade religious education. I loved it, and I continued this ministry for about twenty years. In the mid-eighties, Fr. Caserta began to mention that I should consider becoming a deacon. This went on for years.

In 2003, I enrolled in the Lay Pastoral Ministry Program, and twelve years later, I enrolled in the Tribunal Course – both were prerequisites for the diaconate. I still wasn't sure about becoming a deacon. Finally, I believe it was in 2016 that I applied for the diaconate and was accepted into the upcoming class. The Lord was at work in all of this. At one point, a St. Charles parishioner came up to me and said, "You are either a deacon or you're going to be one." A year later, as I was touring the Holy Land, a woman from Nebraska said to me, "You are either a deacon or you should be!" Neither of these women had any way of knowing this unless it came from the Holy Spirit. Between my second and third years of formation, I decided to drop out of formation. All the classwork was taking its toll on me.

Before the fall semester began, my most faithful supporter, Our Blessed Mother, said, "What's the matter? Don't you trust me? Don't you trust my Son?" Well, here I am. She blessed me with the grace to move forward and complete the diaconate formation process!


Take it seriously! If you or someone you know might think you have a call to the religious life. Talk to a priest, deacon, or religious, and seek discernment in your decision. There's only one way to know for sure, and if it's meant to be, God will make it happen! Life satisfaction is found in realizing God's plan for your life!
