STAFF REFLECTIONS

Joe Whatley, Liturgical Music Director St. Albert the Great

Greetings to my new parish family here at St. Albert the Great and our extended parish families at Ascension and St. Charles!

I have thoroughly enjoyed getting to know many of you in the last few months, and I have found this community to be very warm and welcoming.



This is the second opportunity I have had to address this Parish family and I wanted to give you an update. Since arriving in March, I have taken on some new duties at St. Albert the Great which normally fall under the role of a Pastoral Associate. It has been fun and often rewarding.

I would like to mention something that has been on my heart to make this wonderful parish an even more vibrant community: volunteer opportunities. As many of you already know, the Covid lockdowns have disseminated our volunteer pool at St. Albert and I would suspect our other parishes as well. As an example; before Covid we enjoyed having over 90 active Eucharistic Ministers. That has dwindled down to around 35 active Eucharistic Ministers currently. And we could point to many more examples like this throughout all our ministries. Currently I am working with our ministry heads on ways we can make serving more accessible and breaking down the barriers that hold parishioners back from volunteering. We are looking at things such as training videos as opposed to in-person training, our new scheduler program that allows you to schedule seamlessly through the web or a phone app, and more!

No matter how busy you are, there is a ministry that fits into your schedule.

Please reach out to me or anyone on our staff to help you find the ministry that fits you best!

I have always been of the belief that if you are attending a church regularly, you should have at least one volunteer role from your family. When I was a young person attending St. Rita church, I was a Server, Lector, Eucharistic Minister, and a member of the choir. Being active in a church ministry is one of the things that truly make us a community!


