

STAFF REFLECTIONS

Kelly Summers, KCC Youth Ministry

This week's Gospel reading from Matthew involves the parable about a landowner finding laborers for his vineyard. The story goes that throughout the day, from early morning until late in the afternoon, the landowner continues to encounter and invite laborers to work his land. At the end of the day, it is especially a surprise to those who had been working since early



morning, that the last laborers to arrive were paid first and not only that, everyone received the same pay!

The landowner is symbolic of God. He is always there, inviting all who are willing to come and do His good works. The "pay" we are promised and hopeful for, at the end of our lives, is living in eternity in the Kingdom of Heaven.

Thanks be to God that not only those who came to the faith first, or those who are "cradle Catholics" or those baptized as infants are invited to live a life in Christ. This parable is a good reminder that we are each uniquely made and that the path to discipleship can look different for each of us. Regardless of where we are on our paths to be missionary disciples, we are all brothers and sisters in Christ. As we, the Church, the Body of Christ, work to grow God's kingdom, to grow in holiness, to become more like Christ in all we think, say, and do; we are reminded to be merciful, to be humble and to show humility as we serve our neighbors and invite people to join us.

God's gifts are plentiful and there is enough grace and goodness for all of us. I am so thankful for the mercy and patience God has shown me throughout my life, despite the times when I was far from Him.

God patiently awaited an invitation into my heart, as he does for all of His creation. Interestingly, my father, my sister, and I are all converts to the faith. Finding the Catholic faith, being invited and welcomed in, and having a chance to have eternal life with Christ, despite being "late to the game" is a tremendous blessing.


