STAFF REFLECTIONS

CHRISTIAN COSAS, Music Director St. Charles

For close to 30 years, I have struggled with some form of depression. I feel silly having to qualify and explain this, but I think it's important to say: I bring it up to normalize it and remove its stigma. I feel strongly that the more we show



transparency about mental illness and its prevalence in the general population, the more we can become healthier individuals and a healthier society.

I also feel a little silly assuring people that I'm really fine, most of the time. The COVID-19 pandemic hit all of us hard and definitely took its toll on those of us with mental health issues. I take care of myself by attending counseling sessions and taking medication. I've not always been so diligent about taking care of myself, and those are the moments when I slip into what St. John of the Cross called, "The Dark Night of the Soul."

I do take comfort in knowing that many of the saints have suffered from depression. I feel like I'm in good company with not only John of the Cross, but also Augustine, Ignatius of Loyola, Elizabeth Ann Seton, Clare of Assisi, and Mother Theresa of Calcutta.

Of course, as a musician, music is balm for me. Musicians throughout history have expressed their own depression through music, from Gustav Mahler to Modest Mussorgsky to Nick Drake to Billie Eilish. One of my favorite sacred pieces is the simple Taizé ostinato that we frequently sing at the Easter Vigil: "Within our darkest night, you kindle the fire that never dies away, never dies away."

I'm not looking for attention or pity. I am looking for a listening ear and a shoulder to cry on, when I need them. I'm looking for solidarity, empathy, and a willingness to accompany not only me, but also all those who experience depression. I am, and they are, looking for understanding without judgment. Most of all, I'm looking to comfort anyone who might be reading this to assure them: You are not alone. If you or a loved one needs help, call 988 or visit 988lifeline.org.
