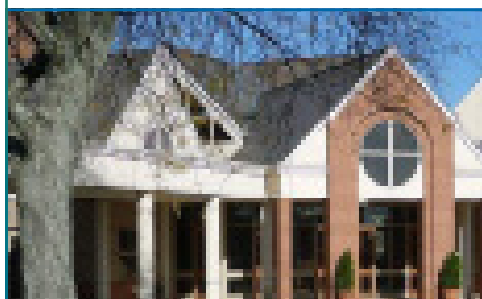

STAFF REFLECTIONS

Ann Gross, Business Manager, Ascension



In my last writings, the themes were gardens, closets and children. This time, I could not think of anything fun to write about. So this one will be more about work here at Ascension and with the Kettering Catholic Community. Each of the business managers have extensive and diverse job descriptions.

We meet every three weeks to talk about successes, setbacks, frustrations and how to better help each other through the Beacons of Light process. We are building relationships with each other and looking at all processes to better serve the family as we go forward.

Today's gospel is one that should make us discern about our time, talent, and treasure.

Here at Ascension, one of the parts of my job is buildings and grounds. Trying to keep mechanicals running smoothly, buildings and railings standing upright and safe, and outside appearances well-maintained. All of these are not accomplished and perfected at once or do they all work at the same time.

Something always needs a refresh. The largest projects cost over \$149,000 on our 5 buildings and 11 acres. We need many hands and minds to help with this part of the church, school and grounds. If you have an interest, let me know.

Time, talent and treasure.

Another part is handling the finances of the parish. Last week, I included in the bulletin our financial statement for the year July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023. The results were better than expected. Each department is responsible for helping set and control their budget. Everyone is invested in controlling their budget and doing the most with what is available to them. The school was awarded a safety grant and was able to upgrade some security with more upgrades coming in 2023-2024. The school also received a very generous bequest that we have set aside for future use. The church did help to support the school with almost \$280,000. All of this would not be possible without the generous tithing of our parishioners. **Time, talent and treasure.**

Many years ago, when Father Chris was pastor, Joe and I were asked to speak about Time, Talent and Treasure and how it impacted our family. Time and talent were the easy subjects. So we were asked to focus on how our finances directly impacted what we tithed and how we were blessed with the giving. Stewardship has been a big part of our faith life then and now. As we go through the bumps of the Beacons of Light, I ask that you discern your time, talent and treasure to help this family of parishes to continue to serve you and bring glory to God.
