ON THE JOURNEY

Father Ed Pratt, Pastor



Parish?...Parish??...Parish???

As we move quickly into our second year as the Kettering Catholic Community since the Archdiocese's Beacons of Light initiative, it has become apparent to me that the word parish is used and understood differently by many of us.

"Parish" basically has three meanings and we tend to use them interchangeably or we may hear the word used in a manner when another definition is the intention. Using them interchangeably can cause confusion.

Parish. (n.)

1. The people of God within a particular boundary. God's people coming together in union with a common faith.
2. A physical structure or buildings where people come to worship and gather.
3. A legal entity for canon/church law or civil law that defines purpose and rights.

As you can see, these definitions vary and most of us have one particular meaning that we think of first when we hear the word. As we look to our future, I think it might be worth looking at our situation and our possible future in light of all three definitions.

First, (Definition 1) We are the people of God in this particular Kettering region. We are faith-filled people of God.

Second, (Definition 2) We have three locations that are large facilities where we gather for worship, formation, sacraments, recreation and many other things that happen in our buildings.

Third, (Definition 3) We are an organization identified by the Archdiocese, local government agencies and other church organizations that provides services, employment, and could share fiscal responsibilities.

While the Archdiocese has challenged us to be one parish in the coming years, the best way to look at this is through the lens of **Definitions 1 and 3**. We are working at sharing ministries, serving one another and praying together as God's people—**Definition 1**. When the time comes, the Archbishop will decree that there is one parish "doing business" in Kettering and it will be named accordingly through a canonical process—**Definition 3**.

Both of these do not affect Definition 2 as it deals with physical structures and locations. A parish can have multiple locations and facilities. Our most likely scenario, knowing I cannot completely predict the future, we will be one parish of God's people, officially recognized in a legal manner, serving God and His people in more than one physical setting.

Be sure to ask for a clarification of parish, if you need to!

Let's continue on our journey with God and one another.

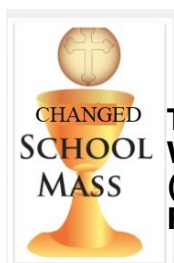

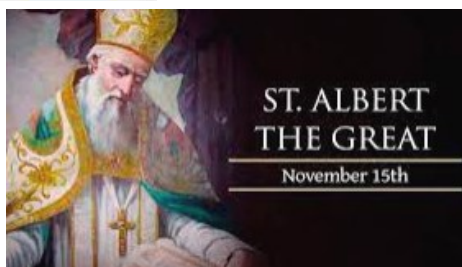

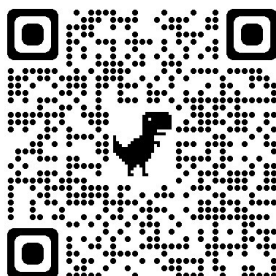

WHERE DOES IT SAY THAT?



THIS CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT...

THREATENS PARENTAL RIGHTS

By using "individual" instead of adult or woman, anyone under the age of 18 could have an abortion or make any other reproductive decision without their parents' consent or notification.

PUTS WOMEN AT RISK

Current Ohio laws* require abortion providers to explain procedure risks and ensure access to hospital transfer if needed. These health and safety standards could be seen as a "burden" and be eliminated, making it even less safe for women seeking an abortion.

ALLOWS ABORTIONS THROUGH 9 MONTHS OF PREGNANCY

In U.S. law,** "health" includes age or physical, emotional, or psychological well-being. This means a woman's age or emotional health could be cited to justify aborting a full-term baby. An abortion-providing physician would decide when a baby could survive outside the womb, leaving no clear protections for preborn children.

IS MISLEADING

Referring to "miscarriage care" promotes a myth that a "right to abortion" is necessary to preserve care for miscarriages and ectopic pregnancies. This is false. Catholic hospitals have always provided comprehensive miscarriage care and will continue to do so regardless of the outcome of this vote.

ARTICLE I, SECTION 22

*The Right to Reproductive Freedom
with Protections for Health and Safety*

1. Every individual has a right to make and carry out one's own reproductive decisions, including but not limited to decisions on contraception, fertility treatment, continuing one's own pregnancy, miscarriage care, and abortion.
2. The State shall not, directly or indirectly, burden, penalize, prohibit, interfere with, or discriminate against either an individual's voluntary exercise of this right or a person or entity that assists an individual exercising this right, unless the State demonstrates that it is using the least restrictive means to advance the individual's health in accordance with widely accepted and evidence-based standards of care.
3. However, abortion may be prohibited after fetal viability. But in no case may such an abortion be prohibited if in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient's treating physician it is necessary to protect the pregnant patient's life or health.
4. As used in this Section, "Fetal viability" means "the point in a pregnancy when, in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient's treating physician, the fetus has a significant likelihood of survival outside the uterus with reasonable measures. This is determined on a case-by-case basis"; and "State" includes any governmental entity and political subdivision.
5. This Section is self-executing.

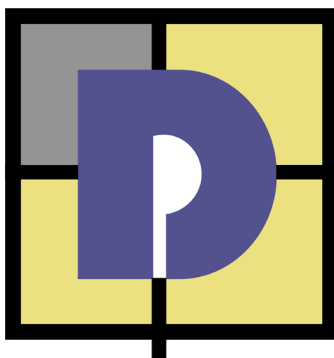
