

As I reflect on the Gospel message for this weekend, it reminds me of the importance of serving others. Serving others is more than keeping up with our to-do list. To be a servant means we genuinely need to care about people, even the unlovable. Jesus never stressed about time, what others thought of Him, or a list of tasks to accomplish each day. No task was ever beneath Him, and no person was ever unworthy.

In a world that surrounds us with bitterness and negativity, this is not always easy. Only Christ's love can help us to be peaceful, faithful, and generous with our time.

For those of you who may know me as the Director of Alumni Relations at Archbishop Carroll High School, you are probably wondering why I am sharing my reflection today. However, I do realize there is always more that I could do for others if I could find more time to share my gifts.

As we approach the Advent Season, our schedules get busier and our lives become a little bit crazier. It is difficult to look outside our own needs and our own struggles.

My prayer for this weekend is for guidance in keeping our eyes, hearts, and schedules open and to allow the Spirit of God to help us serve, love, and help others with humility.






We are bringing back the Precious Blood of Christ in our liturgies. The layout for distribution is very similar to how it was before Covid.
