Matthew 25:40

As I reflect on the Gospel message for this weekend, it reminds me of the importance of serving others. Serving others is more than keeping up with our to-do list. As we approach the Advent Season, our schedules get busier and our lives become a little bit crazier. It is difficult to look outside our own needs and our own struggles.

My prayer for this weekend is for guidance in keeping our eyes, hearts, and schedules open and to allow the Spirit of God to help us serve, love, and help others with humility.

Blood of Christ

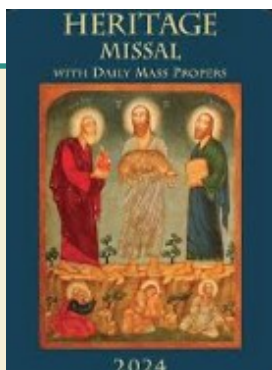
We are bringing back the Precious Blood of Christ in our liturgies. The layout for distribution is very similar to how it was before Covid.

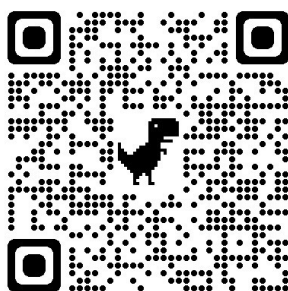
