#### STAFF REFLECTIONS

#### Fr. Tom Nevels, Sr. Parochial Vicar

#### My friends in Christ,

Back around 1980, during confession, a priest encouraged me to get a "New Saint Joseph People's Prayer Book" and find some prayers in there that I liked to enhance my prayer life. I have been using that prayer book since then.



I thought I would share with you one of my favorite prayers therein, which I have prayed many times over the years. Sometimes I just spend time contemplating various sentiments of this prayer. It is number 521, page 417 entitled, "Prayer for All Things Necessary for Salvation," authored by Pope and Scholar Clement XI (1649-1721). Here they are:

I believe Lord, but may I believe more firmly. I hope Lord, but may I hope more securely. I love Lord, but may I love more ardently. I grieve Lord, but may I grieve more deeply. I adore you as my first beginning. I aspire after you as my last end. I praise you as my perpetual benefactor. I invoke you as my merciful protector.

I desire whatever you desire. I desire it because you desire it. I desire it insofar as you desire it. I desire for as long as you desire it.

I pray, O Lord, that you will enlighten my mind, inflame my will, cleanse my heart, and sanctify my soul.

May I repent of past sins, repel future temptations, correct wicked tendencies, and cultivate virtuous ideals.

Good Lord, grant that I may love you, renounce myself, do good to my neighbor, and be detached toward the world.

May I strive to obey my superiors, support my inferiors, aid my friends, and spare my enemies.

Help me to overcome sensuality by self-denial, avarice by liberality, anger by meekness, and tepidity by devotion.

Make me prudent in council, steadfast in danger, patient in adversity, and humble in prosperity.

Grant, Lord, that I may be attentive at prayer, temperate at meals, diligent at work, and constant in resolutions.

Let my conscience be upright, my outward appearance be modest, my conversations be edifying, and my whole life be ordered.


Help me to labor to overcome nature, to cooperate with your grace, to keep your commandments, and to further my salvation.

Teach me the futility of earthly things, the greatness of divine things, the shortness of temporal things, and the length of eternal things.






The Kettering Catholic Community will implement the following policy for Masses:

- Weekend Masses will continue as scheduled unless there is a terrible blizzard. Cancellations will appear on WHIO.
- Funerals will continue, taking into account advice and plans from funeral homes and families.
- Daily Mass will be canceled at any location where that location's school is on delay or closed. It is possible that not all school locations will be delayed or closed on the same day, but we want to be consistent—delay or closed school: that location has no daily Mass.
   Decisions on Daily Masses on days when school is not in session will be handled by Father Ed in consultation with the other priests. Check WHIO for cancellations.


