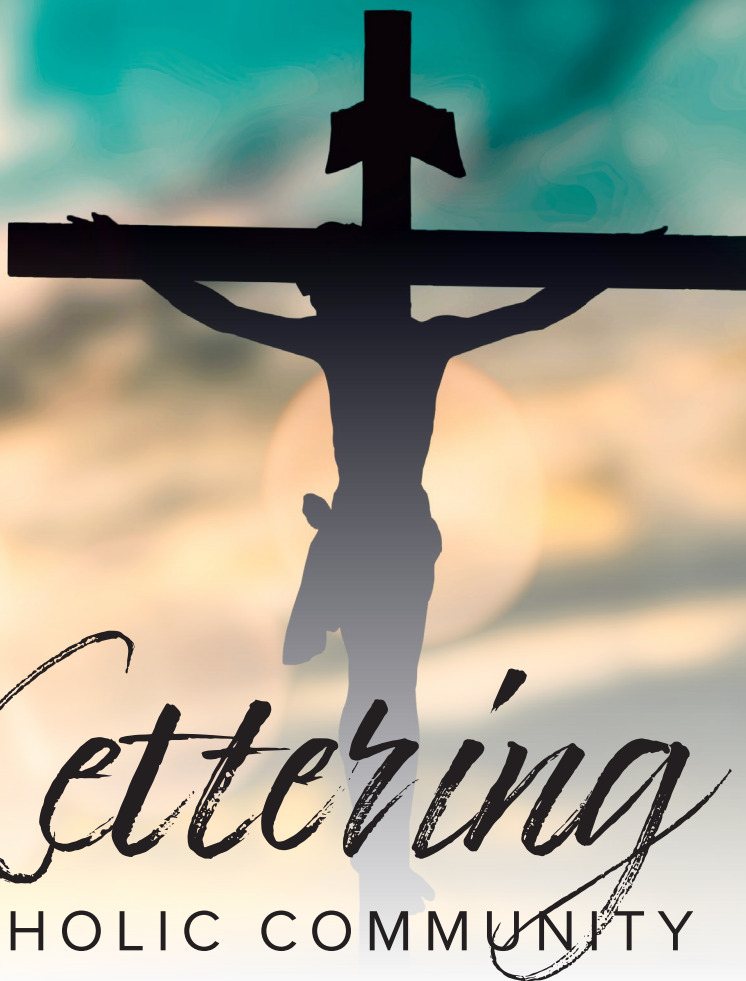

STAFF REFLECTIONS

Joe Ollier, Director of Evangelization



There's something about winter that really makes me struggle. Maybe it's the bleakness of heavy gray skies, the dull, barren trees and the brown lawns. Maybe it's the harsh, biting cold that seems to cut right to my bones. I know there are some folks who love winter, but I feel like I survive it. From the time the last leaf falls from our trees, I long for Spring. Some time in the next few weeks, I'm sure I'll start looking for the first signs of the crocuses poking through the frost and snow, even though I know it's way too early.

But as much as I hate winter, I also know that there is great value to this season. The cold is necessary to kill off invasive species and diseases that harm our native plants and wildlife. This dormant period gives our grass, flowers and trees time to strengthen their roots and make them more able to withstand the heat of summer. The rain, sleet and snow have a chance to sink deep into the soil, saturating the earth and giving life to everything they touch.

While the landscape appears lifeless, there's so much going on under the surface to prepare the world for the new life coming in the months ahead, and that new life would not be possible without this time of apparent death.

I think the same is true with much of life in general. The darkness of the present moment is never the end. Very often, the thick ice of suffering that seems to encase our lives becomes the oasis from which new life springs. Spiritually, I know the barren times in my prayer life are often preparation for a season of great fruitfulness. And on a larger level - throughout history, great persecution of the Church has always brought forth incredible growth and renewal. One thing our faith tells us is that, in the end, God wins. Darkness and death never have the final word.

Just as I was writing this reflection, I spied a coworker's computer, and her screensaver said "If you choose not to find joy in the snow, you will have less joy in your life but still the same amount of snow".

So much truth there. Very often we cannot choose the winters that enter our lives, but we can choose how to react to them. We can choose to walk (or trudge - in my case) through the winters of our lives knowing that God is working, often under the surface, to do something brand new.

May we learn to embrace the drab and the barren for what they are - opportunities to kill off the invasive habits and sins which harm us, to nourish our roots, and to let our hope in the Lord to sink deep into our souls, saturating our lives, giving life to everything He touches.

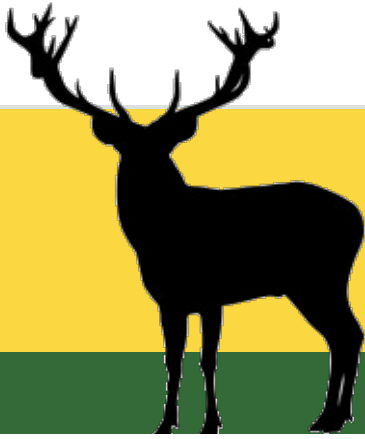

AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER ED PRATT



Approximately two years ago, I was named pastor of the three parishes of Ascension, St. Albert and St. Charles. Together we would work as a Family of Parishes known as the Kettering Catholic Community. We have made a lot of progress in working together and we know there is a lot of work still to come.

As I have continued to evaluate where we have been and where we need to go on this Beacons of Light journey, it is time for a change in leadership.

After much prayer and discernment, and looking at what is best for our Family of Parishes, I have asked the Priests Personnel Board for a new assignment. A new pastor for the Kettering Catholic Community will lead us through the next years of strategic planning and continued development of shared ministries.

In the next few days, the priests of the Archdiocese will receive a notice of the Kettering Pastorate opening and will be able to express their interest in being our next leader.

The Priests Personnel Board, in conjunction with Archbishop Schnurr, will appoint a new Pastor this Spring with his assignment taking effect in July.

I will be with our Kettering Catholic Community until June. I will receive a new assignment this Spring which will begin this Summer.

Please keep me in your prayers as we move ahead in transitioning to a new pastor.
