Father Ed Pratt, Pastor

Father, I have questions about you leaving us...

Thanks to all of you for your words, cards and emails shared with me since it was announced that I have asked for a new priestly assignment. Your affirmation for me and my ministry

has been truly heartwarming. I have had several of you ask questions, so here are some answers.

Are you OK?

Yes, I am fine. My health is good. I have not requested a change due to burnout or any other anxiety, I simply think a change will be best for the Kettering Catholic Community and for me.

At Mass, you are so upbeat—your request for a new assignment is a surprise.

When I am presiding and preaching homilies, as well as when I am providing pastoral or sacramental services, I am truly energized and "in my element." I understand your surprise as many of you only see me in that role. The role of so many other responsibilities and expectations for the pastor of 3 large parishes like ours requires more energy that I can give.

Who's going to be our next pastor?

There is a process where all the priests of the Archdiocese will be informed that an opening for Pastor of the Kettering Catholic Community is open. Priests can let the Priest Personnel Board and the Archbishop know if they wish to apply. The Board and the Archbishop work together to name a new pastor. This process will happen in the coming weeks.

What can I do to help?

Prayer is the number one way to help. Prayers for the new pastor and for me as I continue on my journey. Prayers for the members of the Priest Personnel Board and the Archbishop. Also, when a new pastor arrives, be supportive. Keep him in prayer and give him some time to get used to the many things that happen in our Kettering Catholic Community. Allow him an opportunity to get to know you, the staff and the busy schedule before expecting any proposed changes.

Recognize the talented staff we have and seek their assistance with any needs or suggestions you may have for the parish. I am convinced that all will be fine. The Holy Spirit is leading us in a new and exciting direction. Certainly, there are a lot of questions, but our faith will take us to places only God has planned. I am thankful for all of you, your support and it has truly been an honor to be your pastor.

God is alive, Alleluia! Let's continue on our journey with God and one another. Peace, Father Ed
