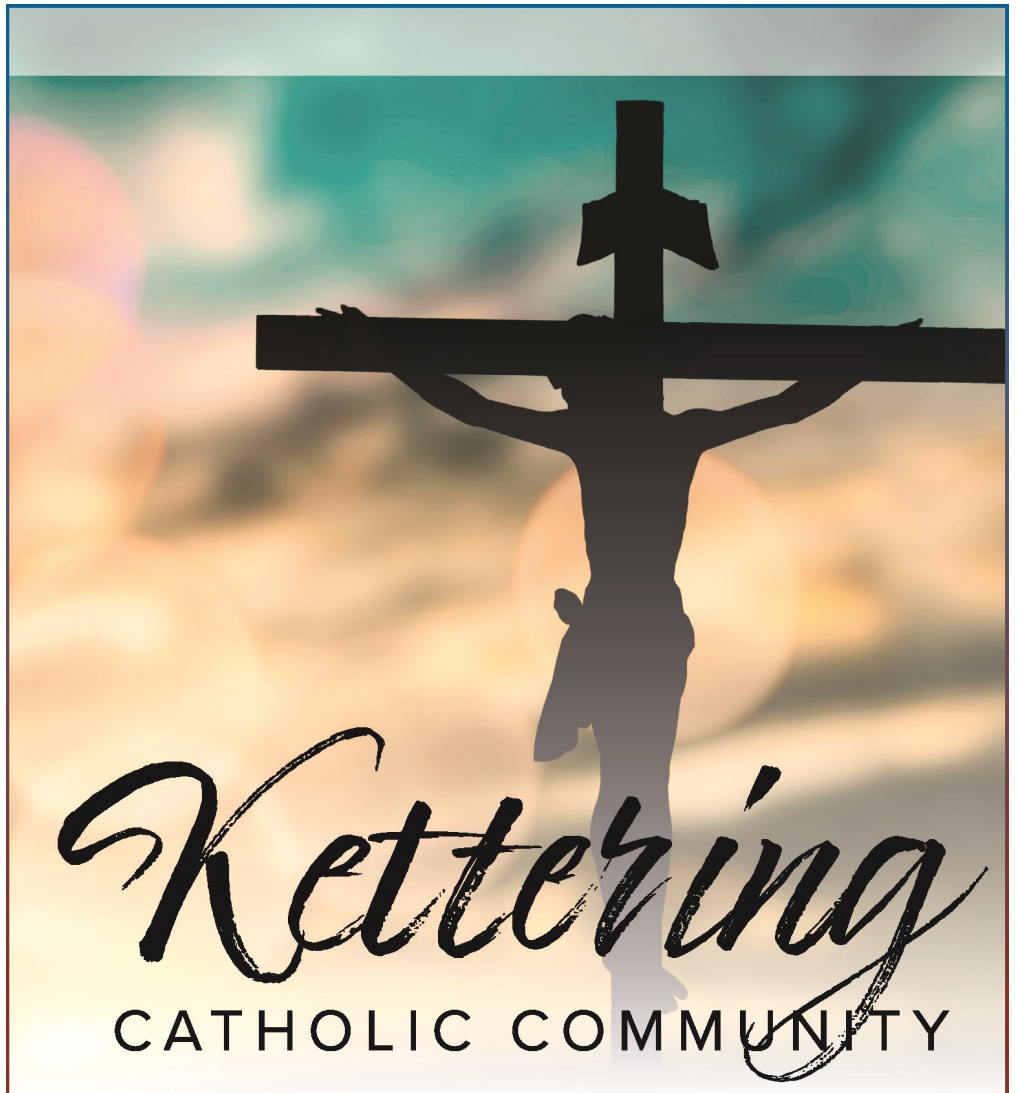

JUST IRON HIS SHIRT

In October of 2023, we knew something was going on because my once crazily active mom got so tired walking only a mile home from the Minster Oktoberfest. This was definitely not normal since she could outwork, outplay and outwalk anyone 30 years younger. After many tests, transfusions and hospital stays, she was diagnosed with acute myeloid leukemia. Not what any of us wanted to hear. More in and out of the James Cancer Hospital and overwhelming exhaustion. We “celebrated” Christmas in the hospital and New Year’s Eve in a different hospital. And then a few days later, she was done fighting. The exhaustion and pain were overwhelming and she was tired and wanted to go home. She was at home only three days in the care of my dad, brother and myself when she passed away. We were all awakened at the same time. The three of us by her side, in the middle of the night she took her last breath.

Then the preparation for the funeral began. It was quick and long all at the same time. Bless those who walk families through this process. My dad and I went to their closet to find something for them both to wear. Finding something for mom was easy. A beautiful pink dress. He had bought a suit the year before that he knew would look nice with her dress since she picked it out. He then found a shirt and tie that went with it. The shirt needed to be washed and pressed. Not something I do a lot of anymore. I took it along thinking I could have it done professionally in Dayton and have it back in time. No luck. So, I returned home, shirt in hand, and washed it with all of the rest. Then came the ironing. Something my mom did for him for 64 years. Something that was now mine to do. A blessed task and a sad task to do so he could look handsome and well kept on the saddest day of his life. So, on this Father’s Day if you are lucky enough to still have your dad around, give him a hug, tell him you love him and just iron his shirt. (Or something else he will appreciate.) And give your mom a hug, too.

WORD ON FIRE: EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

Session 2: Father's Day

Today is a day of thanksgiving for our earthly Father's Love but also for our Heavenly Father's tremendous LOVE in sending us his only begotten Son to suffer and die for our sake that we all may be rescued from sin and death and be able to live in relationship with the Trinity forever. What a beautiful gift! We celebrate the great LOVE of the Bridegroom for the Bride, the Church who is us, intimately at every Mass. We participate by uniting our sacrifices with that of Jesus and reaching the height at the time of the GREAT AMEN. "Amen" is a Hebrew word which has never been translated into English as its meaning is so much more than just "I believe." After the Great Amen, we proclaim the prayer Jesus taught His apostles, The "OUR" FATHER. In our video this week by Fr. Mike Schmitz, he reminds us, "Much happens at this point in the Mass: At the doxology, the Father accepts the gift of His Son through the power of the Holy Spirit and sends down multiple graces and blessings and peace on His people. We take time to extend this peace to one another. This prepares us to receive His Son in the Holy and Real Presence in the Eucharistic Celebration. We are soaked in the Father's and Trinity's Grace and fulfilled in the colors of the Trinity's LOVE. Our response must be a great longing and love in return and a hearty AMEN. When we received Communion, we are made one with God's divinity and made one with one another in every Eucharist. This is not just a memorial. It is the Real Thing, more than our minds can imagine sometimes! Actually, it is a miracle. We should never receive our Lord in a haphazard fashion. What an insult that would be.

Come join us this Friday morning and listen to the talk Fr. Mike gave to a group of Notre Dame students on the Real Presence. It is a life changer! And, he is very entertaining! By the end, he has tears in his eyes because of his great love for the Eucharist.

GREEN COUNTY EXPO CENTER, JULY 1, 4:30PM-7AM

Eucharistic Procession from Greene County Expo Center (Fairgrounds) to St. Brigid Church on July 1. The procession will begin between 4:30 and 5:00 p.m. Following the arrival of the procession at St. Brigid Church, a Holy Hour is planned that will include a talk from a national Eucharistic speaker and praise and worship music. Priests will also be available to hear Confessions. The Holy Hour is planned to take place between about 5:00 and 6:30 p.m. (Actual time is dependent on procession departure and arrival time.) Following the Holy Hour, a community meal will be available for all. The event will feature a display of Eucharistic Miracles by St. Carlo Acutis.
