# FOLLOWING CHRIST'S EXAMPLE IN FAMILY LIFE

In this weekend's Gospel, we witness a moment where Jesus is misunderstood by His own family and accused by the scribes. This passage highlights misunderstandings and divisions, but also Jesus' steadfast commitment to His divine mission. As a mother of four, I find profound lessons in this scripture, particularly about teaching our children right from wrong in an often divided and

confusing world.

Raising a family in these times, much like Jesus facing skepticism and opposition, requires patience, understanding, and a clear sense of purpose. Just as Jesus remained grounded in His mission despite external doubts, we too must stay committed to instilling values of truth, compassion, and unity in our children. Our role is to guide them, teaching them to discern right from wrong, much like how Jesus guided His followers with unwavering principles.

Jesus said, "If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. If a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand." This message is especially relevant today. Our communities often face divisiveness, and fostering a spirit of unity starts within our own homes. By teaching our children to work together and support one another, we build a foundation of cooperation and mutual respect. This unity within the family becomes an example of the broader societal harmony we hope to see.

Moreover, Jesus' response to His family's concerns underscores the importance of responding with compassion and clarity. When He says, "Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother," He expands the concept of family to include all who live by love and righteousness. Teaching our children that family extends to our neighbors fosters a sense of community and shared responsibility.

In our professional and personal lives, let us embrace these Gospel lessons by working together and showing kindness to others, despite our differences. Just as Jesus extended His family to all believers, we can extend compassion and understanding beyond our immediate circles. By doing so, we contribute to healing divisions and creating a more unified, caring community.

May we continue to draw inspiration from Jesus' example, teaching our children and each other to live by the principles of love, compassion, and unity.

#### WORD ON FIRE: EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

Session 2: "Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you; he who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him." (JOHN 6:53-56)



The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage is traveling through the Archdiocese of Cincinnati! Join the pilgrims on their journey as they accompany Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament to the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis.

#### GREEN COUNTY EXPO CENTER, JULY 1, 4:30PM-7AM

Eucharistic Procession from Greene County Expo Center (Fairgrounds) to St. Brigid Church on July 1. The procession will begin between 4:30 and 5:00 p.m. Following the arrival of the procession at St. Brigid Church, a Holy Hour is planned that will include a talk from a national Eucharistic speaker and praise and worship music. Priests will also be available to hear Confessions. The Holy Hour is planned to take place between about 5:00 and 6:30 p.m. (Actual time is dependent on procession departure and arrival time.) Following the Holy Hour, a community meal will be available for all. The event will feature a display of Eucharistic Miracles by St. Carlo Acutis. After the evening meal and celebration, Adoration and Confession will be available in St. Brigid Church overnight until 7:00 a.m. Tuesday morning.


