STAFF REFLECTION

With his feast day coming up on the 22nd, I thought I would steal some notes from Pope John Paull II. In his first homily after becoming pope, John Paul II urged Catholics everywhere to take a deeper look into their faith. One of his most famous lines comes from this homily: "Do not be afraid. Open wide the doors for Christ." What does this mean? And why do those words still resonate with us nearly 50 years later? In the simplest terms: faith in Christ and a commitment to His church does not grow old, unrelatable, or irrelevant, and actually makes our lives

more vibrant and fulfilling.

In this first homily, JPII stressed Peter's remark when Jesus asks who the apostles say that He is: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Peter is telling Jesus that he believes He is the messiah. That He is God, the creator of the universe. That he believes Jesus is the one sent to save mankind from sin and death. That He is the one we should be putting our faith into and following. It is necessary to take a look into our own faith and ask ourselves, "Do I believe this? Do I look at Jesus as my lord and savior? If I believe that, what impact does it have on how I live my life?"

When we ask ourselves that question, we may not like the answer. It can be difficult to keep Christ at the center of our lives amidst the hustle and demands of life, and remembering that Christ is Lord may not seem relevant when we're standing in line at the grocery store or the bank, or finishing up a project at work, or trying to get the kids to eat their peas. But, even in the busyness, it is important to remember that Christ is always by our side, asking us to grow deeper in relationship with Him. He is always knocking on the door to our hearts, and asking us to say yes to Him. Asking us to let Him in.

Inviting Jesus in may cost us. Scratch that. It WILL cost us. It will cost us our time, energy, security, and more than anything our comfort zones and our very hearts. Jesus is asking us to give Him nothing less than our entire lives. And is it worth it? Is it worth it to give ourselves over to the Lord? This is a question that only we can answer for our own life. Saying yes could mean anything from smiling at someone when you walk by them or moving across the country to be a missionary. All I can say is that saying yes to the Lord has led me to a more abundant life and places I could never imagine (Like Kettering, Ohio). I encourage you all to go to Him in prayer and listen to where the Lord may be calling you to say yes to Him, and consider asking yourself the question: "Is it worth it to give all of myself to a creator who loves me entirely?"




