



#### **MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

Dear Family of Parishes,

As we celebrate Respect Life Sunday on this first Sunday of October, our Church asks us to continue and deepen our efforts at supporting and protecting all human life, especially in its most fragile and dependent stages. In God's eyes, nothing is more precious and valuable than human life. Accordingly, we strive to follow God's love in this.

Our effort at eliminating abortions is not going to happen through passing laws, but rather by creating a society that rejoices in and supports mothers in all regards, from conception and throughout childhood, so that no mother feels a need to end her pregnancy due to pressure or fear, but feels confident and supported in creating new human life.

Likewise, we are reminded on Respect Life Sunday that existing human life experiencing any need demands our best efforts in support and care. This would include the poor, sick, disabled, marginalized, incarcerated, alienated and any other human being needing some brotherly love.

On the third Sunday of this month, October 20, we celebrate World Mission Sunday. On this Sunday, Pope Francis asks us to support the 1,200 mission dioceses around the world through his Pontifical Mission Society's collection. This is a chance to help people we likely will never meet in this life, but they will have a chance to thank us in eternity, as we thank them for their prayers for us. In all of this, we show love for our Lord by showing love for others, a constant Gospel message.

I am grateful to announce a new staff member at St. Albert the Great. Amanda Ortiz will be our new communications specialist at St. Albert. Amanda is originally from Puerto Rico, is part of a military family and most recently moved here from Louisiana. She will be a gift from God to us. Please make her feel welcome.

Thank you to all who have taken part in our Family of Parishes name initiative. It is going to be inspiring.

All three parishes will come together to celebrate one Memorial Mass for those who died this past year. That Mass will be said on All Souls' Day, Saturday, November 2 at Church of the Ascension at 9:30 p.m.

We had our first implementation leadership meeting in late September. As usual, I was very impressed with the people on board, and accordingly, I anticipate great things flowing from this effort. Please keep them in your prayers.

#### CHANGING THE NAME OF KETTERING CATHOLIC COMMUNITY

At the recent Town Halls, several parishioners expressed a desire for a more sacred name for our Family of Parishes. With that in mind, we have developed an online survey for all adults, children, and teens who are connected to our churches and schools to suggest names (within the parameters noted below) and the reason for that suggestion. The survey is currently active and will close on October 7. We value your input and hope you will submit a name nomination.

The results from the survey will be tabulated, and shared with the Family Leadership Team. Five names will then be selected for ballot box voting in mid-November. The final name chosen will be submitted to our pastor and the Chancery at the Archdiocese for acceptance. A public announcement will be made following the acceptance by the end of December. Our new Family name may or may not become the name of our one canonical parish, which likely will not happen for several years. That will need to be approved by whomever Pope Francis names as Archbishop Schnurr's successor once his retirement becomes official.

While considering name ideas, keep in mind:

- PRAY: We ask that you prayerfully discern a name that will represent all 3 of our parishes.
- MAY be a name of the Blessed Virgin Mary (under some title already approved for use in the liturgy, such as Our Lady of \*\*\*) the name of a saint, or the name of an angel. The name is a heavenly patron who will intercede for us and whom we can invoke in prayer.
- MAY be the name of an essential mystery of the faith (e.g., Ascension, Assumption, Nativity)
- MAY NOT be the name of a "Blessed"; without special permission of the Vatican (i.e. Blessed Carlo Acutis) MAY NOT be one of the three Divine Persons since they are not intercessors.


