



DECEMBER 9, 2024 HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION

In 2024, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be celebrated on Monday, December 9, as it has been transferred from December 8, the Second Sunday of Advent. Unlike previous practices where the obligation was abrogated when the date was moved, attendance at Mass will now be required. Bishop Thomas Paprocki sought clarification from the Holy See regarding this obligation, and the Dicastery for Legislative Text confirmed that the feast must be observed as a day of obligation. Therefore, December 9, 2024, will be a Holy Day of Obligation for Catholics.
