GOD IS WITH US, NO MATTER THE MOMENT



Did you ever receive a holiday card in the mail with a family portrait and wonder—how long did it take for them to make that happen? The picture looks almost too perfect with the parents, kids and dog all smiling and not a hair out of place. I wonder if that picture was really reflective of the state of that family at that moment or was there a bit of shuffling, grumbling or bribery behind the scenes? My daughter sent me a very honest picture of my granddaughter this year that was taken for her daycare photo. It was funny and very real. We certainly do have those moments of great joy,

love and success where life seems to come together. It is also true that sometimes life doesn't go according to plan at all and we find ourselves in struggle, pain, or just exhausted from the pace.

The promise of Christmas is not the shining Christmas photo where everything is perfect, but the Good News that whatever your Christmas looks or feels like this year, our God has promised to be born right into the middle of it. Throughout the Season of Advent, we hear the prophets of the Hebrew Scriptures promise salvation, restoration and the hope that God would raise up His people. At Christmas, we learn that it is Jesus who fulfills this hope for all. "The virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel, which means 'God with us.'" (Matt. 1:23) Emmanuel–God with us–is one of my favorite titles for Jesus. God is with us in the good parts and the hard parts of being human. God is with us when we are feeling strong and loving our lives. And God is with us when we are barely hanging on through the day-to-day. What a grace to have a God who truly understands us and wants to be a part of the messiness of our lives, whatever the picture may be.

In my ministry, sometimes people ask me how to begin to know and feel this Jesus, "God with us," in their lives. Here are a few ways to begin or to reconnect if it has been a while. Start with a simple daily prayer asking Jesus to be present to you and guide you. Take time to read the Bible stories of Jesus (it is still Scripture if you read it on your phone). Finally, talk to others who seem to be living and practicing their faith. They can help you learn to recognize what we celebrate at Christmas: God indeed is with us.


