

## **STAFF REFLECTION**

This year, we are celebrating the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception on Monday, December 9. There has been some confusion about why it was moved to a Monday and if it is still a Holy Day of Obligation (yes, it is). But all that aside, I think it is an awesome chance to reflect on how the Immaculate Conception of Mary shows us just how much God loves us.

From the very beginning, God has loved us and wanted to share His life with us. When sin entered the world, we turned away from that love. 




