Each Friday, scheduling permitting, we will expose the Blessed Sacrament for Adoration following the Noon Mass. This will occur each week in conjunction with Confessions.



ACTS XXIX: SPARK YOUR CORE FAITH SET IT ABLAZE IN 2025!

"...the Holy Spirit came upon all who heard the message. The circumcised believers...were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on the Gentiles. For they heard them speaking in tongues and praising God" (Acts 10:44-46)

Session 6: HOW CAN I BE FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT?

Our recent popes, Pope Paul VI, John Paul II, and Pope Francis all agreed that the Holy Spirit was being poured out abundantly in our times. Our Church and our world are in such a crisis! They all saw a new Pentecost and a new hope on the horizon. All Catholics received the Holy Spirit in Baptism and Confirmation, but it often has remained dormant. What do we have to do to awaken what we already have within us?

Ephesians 5 says, "Be filled." We need to long to be filled with the Holy Spirit and not to be afraid of it. We need to be receptive and informed as to who the Holy Spirit is, his gifts, charisms and how he empowers us to use our gifts. Some people receive tongues as a prayer language, but not all Christians. It is not necessarily a sign of being filled with the Spirit. It is just a gift some receive. There are no first- or second-class Christians. It is not the most important gift. We receive the Holy Spirit by praying for it, being prayed over by another for it. Just saying the simple "Come, Holy Spirit" prayer is enough. We need to believe and persevere. God wants to see His gifts come alive within all of us for the building up of the Church. He wants to empower us to be His light and witnesses to the ends of the earth. "He wants His world back" as Fr. Riccardo says. We are His instruments to fulfill that dream, and the Holy Spirit is the person who will give us the power, strength and guidance to do just that! Come, Holy Spirit, Come! Praise to the Father, Son, Holy Spirit!
