This is a very special weekend for our Mother of God Family of Parishes. We celebrate the Second Sunday of Easter, also known as the Sunday of Divine Mercy, and we are blessed to welcome 96 young men and women into our Church as they

St. Faustina Kowalska began having visions of Jesus in her 20s, and they continued until her death at the age of 33. She left behind her diary and a devotion to Jesus known as the Divine Mercy, which later inspired Pope St. John Paul II to declare the Sunday after Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday. In her diary, Faustina wrote, "I hope against all hope in the ocean of Your mercy" (CCC 309), and in another passage, "I do not expect help from people, but place my trust in God. In His unfathomable mercy lies all my hope" (CCC 681).

Jesus' mercy is far greater than our deepest sin, and He longs to extend that mercy to every single person. There is indeed hope for all people—even those in the darkest sin or deepest despair.






